



Or the mysterious stone formations, silent witnesses from an extinct culture that lived here thousands of years ago.

Visiting the Pink Granite Coast is an absolute highlight, but other parts in our region are equally worth a visit! You will be surprised by the beauty and quietness of most nature parks or protected areas.

A very well-kept secret for example, yet to be discovered, is the Sillon de Talbert: this phenomenon, a stretch of dunes that extends into the sea, unique in Europe, can only to be visited at low tide.

Strangely shaped boulders are everywhere on the Pink Granite Coast, sometimes balancing in surprising positions.

These expressive rock formations can be found on the whole coast and the locals have given the most important ones imaginative names, such as "the Bottle", "the Dice " "the Painter's palette" and "Father Trébeurden".

According to geologists, the weather carefully carved the pink granite

boulders in the shape as we see them today over a period of 300 million years.

Water filtered into them, altered the rocks, and produced this unique landscape as we know now.

The origin of their colour lies in the slow geological cooling down proces of the subsoil which assembled large grains of mica, grey quartz and feldspar. And that turned out to be a unique combination: the Pink Granite Coast was born.

HERE, NATURE SURPASSES ITSELF



From the Sillon de Talbert, unique in Europe, or the cliffs that overlook the magnificent beach of la Lieue de Grève, landscapes here are very diverse. Beautiful walks or hikes are guaranteed!

At high or low tide, the scenery behind le Grand Rocher, a large rocky cliff with breathtaking views over the beach of Saint Efflam, changes constantly. Take the path that leads to the top, climb the steps and go through the forest to arrive at the viewpoint on its summit. Take in the view and experience how this environment inspired many before you!



A TASTE OF SPRAY AND FREEDOM

The Pink Granite Coast counts numerous beaches to share unforgettable moments with your family.

Surf the waves at Trestel, play volleyball on the Grève Blanche, jump of the diving board at Pors Termen, have fun on a sand yacht at St Efflam beach, climb the rocks at Pors Scaff... or relax among the creeks of Port Blanc and Pleubian. **Discover** the wideness of the seashore at low tide and go for some fishing on foot. Don't forget to check the tides timetable!

Buy your tickets for a boat trip at the Tourist Office to explore the 7 Îles, an archipelago just a few miles off the Pink Granite Coast. Amongst the **27 species of birds** nesting here you will find Atlantic puffins, gannets, guillemots, fulmars, kittiwakes and cormorants. A colony of grey seals also resides here. The series of rocky islets is the largest bird sanctuary in France! A boat trip is also a **great opportunity** to see the Pink Granite Coast from the sea.



Observe the seabirds from a comfortable boat in the protected area of the 7 Îles.



This bird sanctuary was created in 1912 by the Society for the Protection of Birds (LPO) to put an end to the mass hunting of Atlantic puffins. in 1977, it was classified as a French nature reserve and it is as such the oldest nature reserve in France. It hosts the most important seabird colony in France.



Discover the 7 Îles bird-sanctuary trip on a replica of a traditional lobster sailing boat from 1920. Join in to practice sailing techniques if you want to. On board, there is a friendly atmosphere. Stopover for lunch on the Île aux Moines, one of the isles.

Thanks to this diversity, our bays, coasts, rivers, lakes and ponds are a kingdom for fishermen. Whether on the 11,500 hectares (28417 acres) of foreshore that can be discovered during low-tide or along the 786 km (488 miles) of streams and rivers that cross our destination, from their spring to the estuaries.

Since the 18th century coastguards worked from a trail with great views on bays and beaches to detect intruders like smugglers of products as wine, spirits, tobacco and tea. From the 1960s on this path has became a recreational walking path called the GR34. Locals love to go there for a stroll as the landscape changes with the seasons.

We recommend you to take in the beautiful scenery from this path.






This castle and park, listed as a Historic Monument, tells the story of six centuries of (aristocratic) French history.

Settled in the middle of a marvellous forest on a rock dominating the Leguer river, it now stands as a proud witness of Brittany's Heritage and is a magnificent monument of military architecture from the Middle Ages. This castle is located near the Pink Coast into the history of a Renaissance manor house in Trégor. The manor house is steeped in history through its lordly past. Lafayette is said to have stayed here in 1801. Its origins date back to 1427. The current manor was built at the end of the 16th century, then became a farm at the beginning of the 19th century. Today, it open year-round for accommodation, tourism, artists' studios and cultural events.

Travel through time by visiting the Cités de Caractère, freely translated into English as "outstandingly picturesque towns". First town on the list: Tréguier, historical capital of the Trégor, a town with spirit and generosity. Tréguier emits the aura of Saint Yves, advocate for the poor and patron of lawyers around the globe.

Stroll the charming streets, seek out the different painters that live in the town, gaze at the medieval timber houses in rue Ernest Renan. Visit the cathedral built in Gothic style with some Romanesque elements. Enter the cloister which is one of the most magnificent Gothic cloisters in France and end your trip with a visit of Ernest Renan's childhood home, philosopher and writer from the 19th century.



Next up: La Roche-Derrien, a town built in the 11th century on a rocky headland overlooking the Jaudy estuary. As an old fort from the Middle Ages, La Roche-Derrien was the stage for many battles, but was also known in the Trégor as the capital of linnen weavers, hence its nickname Kapital Stoup. The past of the town can be seen through its remains from the Middle Ages: Porte de la Maladrerie, Place du Pilori, Venelle des Anglais, Venelle d'argent, rue de la Fontaine.

Take some time to visit Lannion, economic capital of Tregor, but also historic town and city of art. Along the narrow streets, discover the richness of the town's architecture, its cobbled alleyways, half-timbered houses or slate houses... The emblem of the city remains the church of Brélévenez which dominates the city from the top of its picturesque 142 steps staircase. Be amazed!



THE HOUSE OF ERNEST RENAN

This house, built in the late 16th century, typical for the architecture of the Trégor, became the birth house of Ernest Renan in 1823, a scientist with religious and political philosophy as his main interests. He was hugely influential in his lifetime. Many of the leading figures of the time knew him and read his works. His ideas were considered as progressive and modern. In 1947 his birth house became a museum dedicated to his life and work.


Whether on land or water, you can enjoy the diversity of flora and fauna on a stroll along the river or by the sea.





GET INTO THE DANCE!



The Trégor invites you to share its culture through the rich heritage of the region.

A mix between traditional Breton culture, modern marvels and local hospitality.

Throughout the year, the Tourist Office edits a weekly calendar of events: concerts, dance, circus, festivals, exhibitions, sports events, flea markets... Not to mention the famous Fest Noz: it is time to learn some Breton dance moves!

The Fest-Noz, a true symbol of Breton culture, has been listed in 2012 as an 'Intangible Cultural Heritage of Humanity' by the UNESCO.

A Fest-Noz is a festive gathering where people practice traditional dances from Brittany on the rhythm of music played or sung. And some of these dances date back to the middle ages.
